# Software for Screenplays


How Screenplay writing differs from prose

- Formatting
- No inner thoughts
- Don't include shot notes (mid, wide, close-up)
- Be visual / 1 page per minute

SCENE 1: A HOT MEAL

Back on ship: More space passes by the view port.

Cut to: Raimus' hand pressing the button to seal the outer door. Feet run up to the door as it closes. Hands bang on the other side of the door. Raimus' parents faces are in the door's small window. He hears their muffled voices.

MOTHER
Why are you doing this? We're not sick!

Back on ship: Title of the film, MAROONED, passes by the view port as the ship spins ever more. The camera turns around and slowly moves down the corridor toward the lights in the back cabin.


"Abel. Abel." Joseph panted in between the words, trying to catch his breath.
